



Matzah Rambling is a fun, light-hearted quiz with a twist – there are four separate games, each with a unique way of giving the answers.

Game 1 – Yiddish Kiddush

The quizmaster introduces each round by telling the teams that when giving an answer, they must replace any words starting with a particular letter with a corresponding nonsense word (which may or may not be Yiddish).

Example Question

K → Kvell
S → Svell
D → Dvell

What is the name of the Kashrut authority that owns kosher.org.uk?
Kvell London Bet Dvell (*Kosher London Bet Din*)

Game 2 – Ratzah Mambling

In this game, each answer should be given as a spoonerism of the correct answer.

Example Question

What do we sit at on the 1st and 2nd nights of Pesach?
Teder Sable (*Seder Table*)

Game 3 – Talk Like An Egypt-Chain

For this game, the aim of each round is to construct a sentence chain.

Example Question

1. In what part of the body would you find the retina?
EYE
2. What does the French word 'amour' mean in English?
(EYE) LOVE
3. If you were to give someone '10 dinar' for their work, what action have you just done to them?
(EYE LOVE) PAY
4. What can be black, plastic, and somewhere to dispose of your chametz?
(EYE LOVE PAY) SACK

Game 4 – Ramble Gamble

A seemingly simple question and answer game.

1 point for each correct answer
However, for an incorrect answer deduct 3 points!

Will you gamble? Make sure you're sure before you answer!
No example question here – the twist of this game becomes clear pretty quickly.
